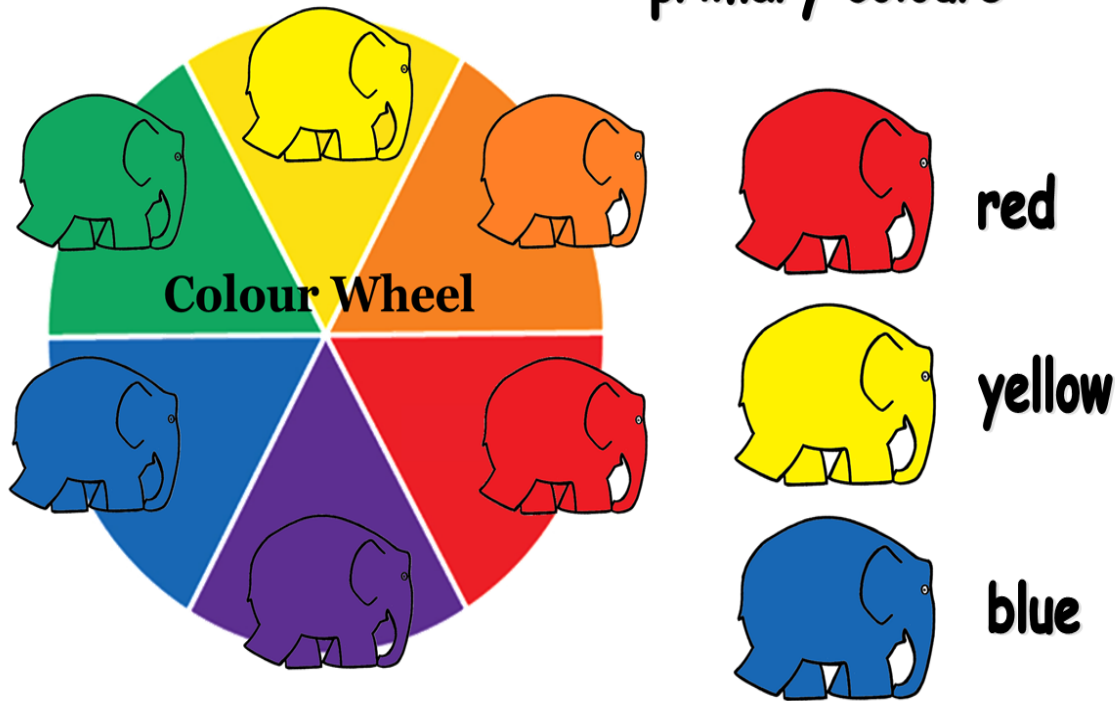




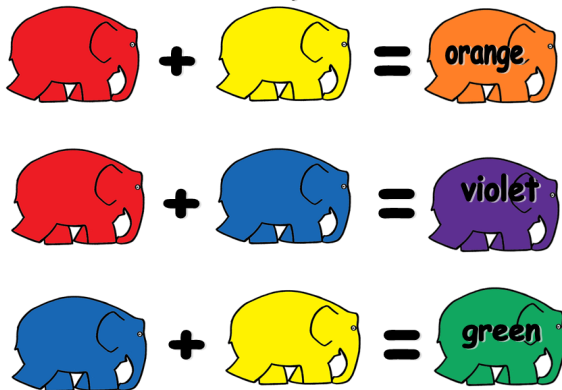

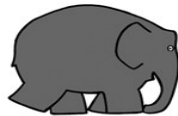
primary colours

WORD KNOWLEDGE (VOCABULARY)

Abstract Art	Art that does not resemble real or natural things.
Background	The area against which a figure or scene is placed.
Collage	Artwork made by gluing pieces of different materials to a flat surface.
Landscape	The depiction of scenery such as countryside, towns and cities and industrial areas.
Patchwork	A pattern created by joining shapes, normally squares, together
Pattern	A repeated decorative design using line, colour, and shape.
Portrait	A drawing or painting of a person's face or body.
Primary Colour	A colour that cannot be made by mixing other colours (red, blue, yellow).
Secondary Colour	A colour made by adding two primary colours together (orange, violet, green).
Shade	Adding black to a colour to make it darker.
Tint	Adding white to a colour to make it lighter.
